



Avlyn Iridescence Quilt -- Finished Size: 54.5" x 66"

Yardage Requirements:

* Yardage based on 44/45" fabrics. Please read through the entire instructions prior to cutting.

- 1 Iridescence Panel #2324-400 (center blocks) (2/3 yard)
- 2 yards Iridescence Border Stripe #2324-300 (top & bottom borders)
- 1/2 yard Iridescence Green Medallion #2324-104 (sashing)
- 1/2 yard Lake Surf #1917-603 (sashing)
- 1/8 yard Yellow Crystal Fusion #1919-302 (cornerstones)
- 1/8 yard Coral Crystal Fusion #1919-311 (cornerstones)
- 3/4 yard Red Crystal Fusion #1919-318 (first border and binding)

Cutting:

LOF = Length of Fabric, WOF = Width of Fabric

From Panel cut:

- 6 Blocks 11.25" x 10.5" (blocks are not square, watch direction for final placement)

From Iridescence Green Medallion cut:

- 3 Strips 1.5" x WOF for sashing (for inside sashing sets)
- 4 Strips 2.5" x WOF for sashing (for outside sashing sets)

From Lake Surf cut:

- 10 Strips 1.5" x WOF (6 for inside sashing sets, 4 for outside sashing sets)

From Yellow Crystal Fusion cut:

- 1 Strip 3.5" x WOF, then cut eight 3.5" x 3.5" blocks.

From Coral Crystal Fusion cut:

- 1 Strip 3.5" x WOF, then cut four 3.5" x 3.5" blocks.

From Red Crystal Fusion cut:

- 4 Strips 1.5" x WOF, cut two 42.5" length, and two 33" length for inside red border.

6 Strips 2.5" x WOF for binding

From Iridescence Border Stripe cut:

4 Strips 10.5" x LOF for outside border. Fussy cut the stripe making sure the dragonflies and flowers are centered on each strip.

Assembly:

**Note: Set and press all seam allowances as directed. Use ¼" seam allowance.*

1. Inside Sashing Sets: Piece the 1.5" Lake Surf strips on both sides of the 1.5" Iridescence Green Medallion strips. Press seams to the green. Make 3 sets. Sets should measure 3.5" by WOF. Cut 4 strips 11.25" long, and cut 3 strips 10.5" long (you'll be able to get 3 per WOF.)
2. Outside Sashing Sets: Piece the 1.5" Lake Surf to one of the 2.5" Green Medallion strips. Press seams to the green. Make 4 sets. Sets should measure 3.5" by WOF. Cut 4 strips 11.25", and cut 6 strips 10.5".
3. Stitch one 10.5" strip between two panel blocks. Press seams to the block. Add the outside sashing to each side. (This should be an outside sashing set, panel block, inside sashing set, panel block, then the outside sashing set. It should measure 31" x 10.5".) Make 3 of these rows.
4. Stitch one 11.25" inside sashing to both sides of a 3.5" Yellow Crystal Fusion square. Stitch another 3.5" yellow block to both sides. (This should be a yellow block, inside sashing, yellow block, inside sashing, and a yellow block.) It should measure 31" x 3.5". Press seams to the yellow blocks. Make 2 sets. Stitch to the top and bottom of 1 block row. Press seams to the sashing. Refer to quilt photo if needed.
5. Stitch another Panel row on top and bottom to create the center of the quilt – 6 blocks plus sashing.
6. Stitch one 11.25" outside sashing set to both sides of a 3.5" Yellow Crystal Fusion square. Stitch a Coral Crystal Fusion square on both sides. Make 2 of these rows. Stitch these to the top and bottom to finish the outside sashing. The pieced unit should measure 31" x 42.5".
7. Stitch the 1.5" x 42.5" Red Crystal Fusion strips to both sides. Stitch the 33" x 1.5" Red Crystal Fusion strips to the top and bottom. Press seams to the outside. The quilt should measure 33" x 44.5".
8. Mark the centers of each side of the quilt with a pin. Find the center of each Iridescence Border strip, and mark it with a pin on the dragonfly side –this will be the side stitched to the quilt – the floral will then be to the outside of the quilt. For the top/bottom borders, measure 16.25" from the center pin to each side and place pins. (You'll want to keep approx 2" of fabric remaining after the pin on the border fabric). Pin the center of the border to the center of the quilt (right sides together so that the dragonflies will be closer to the center of the quilt). The pins in the border should be .25" shorter on each side than the end of the quilt – this will be the start/stop stitching point on each end. For the side borders, measure 22" from the center to each side and place pins. Attach the same as for the top/bottom borders ensuring fabric is placed in the right direction. After stitching the borders on, miter the corners. Fold the quilt at the corner on point, lining up the borders. Mark a line from the corner at the end of stitching to the outside edge of the border strip at a 45 angle, or use your favorite method for mitering corners.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Stitch the binding strips together at a 45 degree angle. Press seams open. Fold strip in half wrong sides together and press. Attach binding to the quilt using your favorite method.
